School Bus Safety - Approaching and passing a stopped bus

The safety of students is of the utmost importance to Christ the Teacher Catholic School

#### Please Remember:

When approaching a school bus, begin to slow down as soon as the flashing amber or red stop lights come on. This is your warning that the bus is either getting ready to stop or has already come to a full stop. You're not allowed to pass the bus in either direction once the flashing red or amber/red lights and stop arm are activated.

#### Also remember to:

- Keep a watchful eye for children running to catch their bus.
- Respect the crossing guards and slow down in school zones.
- During the school year, be especially cautious during periods of the day when students are travelling to and from home.



- Keep a watchful eye for cyclists and pedestrians on roadways.
- When turning at intersections watch out for students using the crosswalks
- Teach your own children about safe conduct in roadways and on school buses.
