MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL :

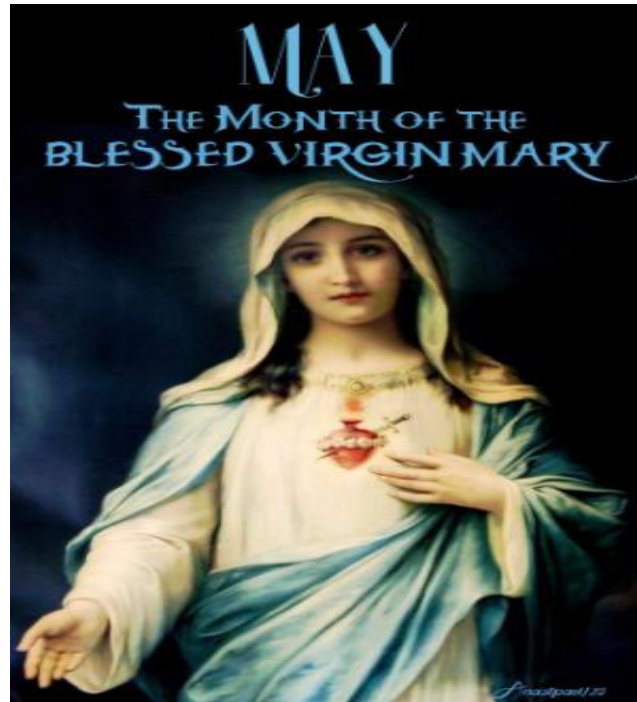
Dear St. Mary's Families,

BGCY Middle Years Programs are for children & youth in Kindergarten through age 12!

All children & youth taking part in any BGC Yorkton Program must have all registration & membership forms completed and turned in!

After-School Program – this program provides children and youth in Kindergarten through age 12 with educational support, physical activity, nutrition, arts & crafts, culture and recreation. The program runs from 3:15 pm to 5:30 pm on all school days during the 2025-2026 School Year. Program is located at 78 First Avenue North.

Learn-To-Cook Program – this drop-in program offers children and youth in Kindergarten through age 12 hands-on opportunities to learn and grow their cooking, nutrition and kitchen skills. This program runs Tuesday evenings from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm. Program is located at 78 First Avenue North.

Arts & Crafts Program – this program allows children and youth in Kindergarten through age 12 with instructed art activities and craft projects using a variety of mediums! This program runs Wednesday evenings from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm. Program is located at 78 First Avenue North.

MY BGC – this program provides children and youth with opportunities to connect with Club staff while taking part in engaging initiatives and physical activity! MY BGC runs Thursdays from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm, with doors only open from 6:15 pm to 6:30 pm. Children in Kindergarten through age 12 can join the fun! Participants need to bring indoor shoes and a water bottle. Program is held at St. Al's School.

Columbia Gym Night – this drop-in program runs at Columbia School in the gymnasium for children and youth in Kindergarten through age 12. The program runs from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm, with doors only open from 6:15 - 6:30 pm. Children should bring a water bottle and indoor shoes and be ready to play a variety of games and sports!

Day Camp – we offer day camps on in-service out-of-school days and break weeks. A day camp runs from 7:45 am to 5:15 pm for the cost of \$30 per day. Spots are limited and registration is required by calling the office at 306-783-2582.
